Date: 2nd October 2022



A total of 72 units of blood were donated by students, staff, and NSS volunteers under the supervision of a team of doctors from Red Cross Society Nanded, Shankar Rao Chavan Government Medical College, Nanded and M.G. M's Medical College & Hospital, Aurangabad. The faculty members, administrative staff, and students of the college participated enthusiastically in the camp. The Institute has two units of the NSS which conducts various activities to fulfill the objectives of the NSS.



Dr. Khairatkar of Shankar Rao Chavan GMC, Nanded informed everyone about the benefits of blood donation. He said that anyone in the age bracket of 18 to 60 years can donate blood and the donated blood is replenished in the body within 24 hours to 48 hours and other elements within 90 days. A healthy person can donate blood every three months.

Reading Room of the Library was utilized as the venue for conducting the activity. A thorough medical check-up of potential donors was done by the medical team. Everyone involved was provided with food glucose water Tea, biscuits, and Chocolates. It was great to see more people turned up for the event than the actual pre-registration numbers.

The samples were carefully sealed and transported away, while the volunteers and hospital staff helped in the clean-up of the area. Throughout the morning, there were smiles and laughter all around - a true embodiment of what we believe in - selfless service with a smile. The donors received a certificate of recognition. They were also given a credit card with which one unit of blood can be obtained freely from Govt. Blood Bank within two years. The NSS unit received a certificate of appreciation from Govt. Blood Bank. The whole event was supervised by NSS Programme officer, Pankaj P. Pawar and his NSS Volunteer team.

Vallabhbhai Patel was dubbed “Sardar” (chief) for his leadership skills in leading the country through the struggle for independence and beyond, most notably during the integration of the princely states and the India-Pakistan War in 1947.

Sardar Patel achieved the incredible feat of persuading almost every single one of the 565 self-governing princely states, that had been released from British suzerainty, to accede to the Union of India. For his commitment to the national integration of the newly independent country, Sardar Patel earned the sobriquet “Iron Man of India”. In college campus run for the Unity marathon was conducted on 31 Oct 2022.

Constitution Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm in MGM's College of Engineering, Nanded, on 26th November 2022 to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On this occasion, a guest lecture was organized and The Chief Guest of the occasion was Dr Gwane, Professor (Political Science) Yeshwant Mahavidyalaya Nanded. He spoke on "Constitutional Protection to Vulnerable Groups: A Human Rights Perspective".

The welcome speech was given by Dr. G. K. Hambarde, Principal in Library Science at MGM's College of Engineering, Nanded. He whole heartedly welcomed the esteemed guest present at the function.

Inaugurating the program, Dr. Gawane emphasized the importance of Constitution Day, the significance of its celebration and commemorated the people who contributed to the development of the Indian Constitution. He mentioned that there are particular groups who, for various reasons, are weak and vulnerable or have traditionally been victims of violations and consequently require special protection for the equal and effective enjoyment of their human rights. He spoke about additional guarantees for persons belonging to these groups. He focused on groups that are especially vulnerable to abuse of human rights; groups that are structurally discriminated against like women and groups, internally displaced persons, national minorities, indigenous peoples, migrant workers, disabled persons, and so on.


